Gardener Rules and Guidelines

- 1) No pets, alcohol, drugs, cigarettes or other tobacco products may be brought into the garden area.
- 2) Supervise children at all times.
- 3) Use no pesticides, herbicides or chemicals.
- 4) Tend to your plot and pathways on a routine basis. If your assigned plot shows no signs of tending for two weeks, you will be contacted. If no response is received within one week of contact, your plot may be assigned to another gardener.
- 5) Inform the Garden Registrar if you no longer desire to use your plot.
- 6) Place weeds and dead plants in the compost area. Do not leave in the pathways.
- 7) Do nothing with another person's assigned plot or plants therein.
- 8) The Garden Taskforce reserves the right to pick and distribute vegetables that are not being harvested.
- 9) Ensure no plant exceeds five feet in height.
- 10) Inform the Garden Registrar if you intend to use your assigned plot over the winter.
- 11) If you are not planning to winter garden, remove all dead plants and non-plant material (string, wood, wire, metal, plastic, etc.) the end of the growing season. Failure to do so may result in denial of garden privileges for the following year.
- 12) Garden only during daylight hours.
- 13) Do not leave running water unattended.

By signing below, I agree that I have read and understand the Gardener Rules and Guidelines and plan to abide by all of the garden rules. I understand that neither the garden group nor owner of the land is responsible for my actions. I therefore agree to hold harmless St. Andrew Lutheran Church and any of its employees, members, and volunteers for any liability, damage, loss or claim that occurs in connection with use of the garden by me or my guests. Failure to abide by these rules may result in forfeiture of my plot without refund.
